

COMMISSIONER CREST OF SERVICE AWARD

The Crest of Service Award was established by the Central Ohio Council in 1980 to recognize all members of the Commissioner's staff for outstanding performance in their assigned position. Criteria for the award have been reviewed in light of past performance and changes in the council. This award for Commissioner service in the Simon Kenton Council consists of:

- A. A certificate that designates the year in which performance is being recognized.
A certificate will be presented for each year awarded.
- B. A special cloth patch that is worn on the official uniform and positioned as a temporary patch centered on the right pocket. Only one patch is provided with the first certificate. Additional awards in subsequent years will be denoted with a service pin to be worn on the patch designating the number of years the award was earned.

The award is made by the District Commissioner at district recognition events. The district is to be responsible for records and determination of recipients based on the following criteria:

UNIT COMMISSIONER

- A. Re-charter 90% or more of assigned units on time.
- B. Have 50% of assigned units qualify as Centennial Quality Units or have an increase in Centennial Quality Units over the previous year.
- C. Visit each assigned Chartered Organization or Unit at least 6 times per year.

2. ASSISTANT DISTRICT COMMISSIONER (Service Area)

- A. Meet 80% of the Unit Commissioner criteria in his/her assigned area.

3. DISTRICT COMMISSIONER.

- A. Re-charter 80% of assigned units on time or achieve a 25% increase in the number of units re-chartering on time from the previous year.
- B. Conduct formal Charter Presentations through Unit Commissioners for 60% of the charters in the District.

4. ROUNDTABLE COMMISSIONER

- A. Conduct 10 Roundtables per year, three of which will include presentations on the re-chartering process.
- B. Record an increase over the previous year in units attending Roundtables or have an average of at least 50% of the units attend in the award year.
- C. Earn the Arrowhead Award.

5. SPECIAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT COMMISSIONER

- A. Award of "Crest of Service" for trouble shooter or special assignment by Assistant District Commissioners will be based on formal recommendation of the District Commissioner and submitted to, and approved by the Council Commissioner.
