



WILDERNESS FIRST AID TRAINING

The cost is \$50 and you must attend both sessions. Participants must bring their own lunch. Instruction is in a classroom setting with some sections held outdoors, so please plan accordingly and dress for the weather.

The Wilderness First Aid course provides an intensive 16 hours of training covering injury assessment, rescuer safety, bleeding, shock, orthopedic injuries, long term patient care, and treatment with materials at hand during practice sessions. When you are participating in outdoor activities that take you more than 1 hour away from medical care, wilderness first aid provides a significant difference in survival and effects of injuries.

This course is a requirement for units traveling to Philmont or participating in some high adventure activities when medical help may be delayed.

Participants need to be 14 years of age or older in order to participate!
